

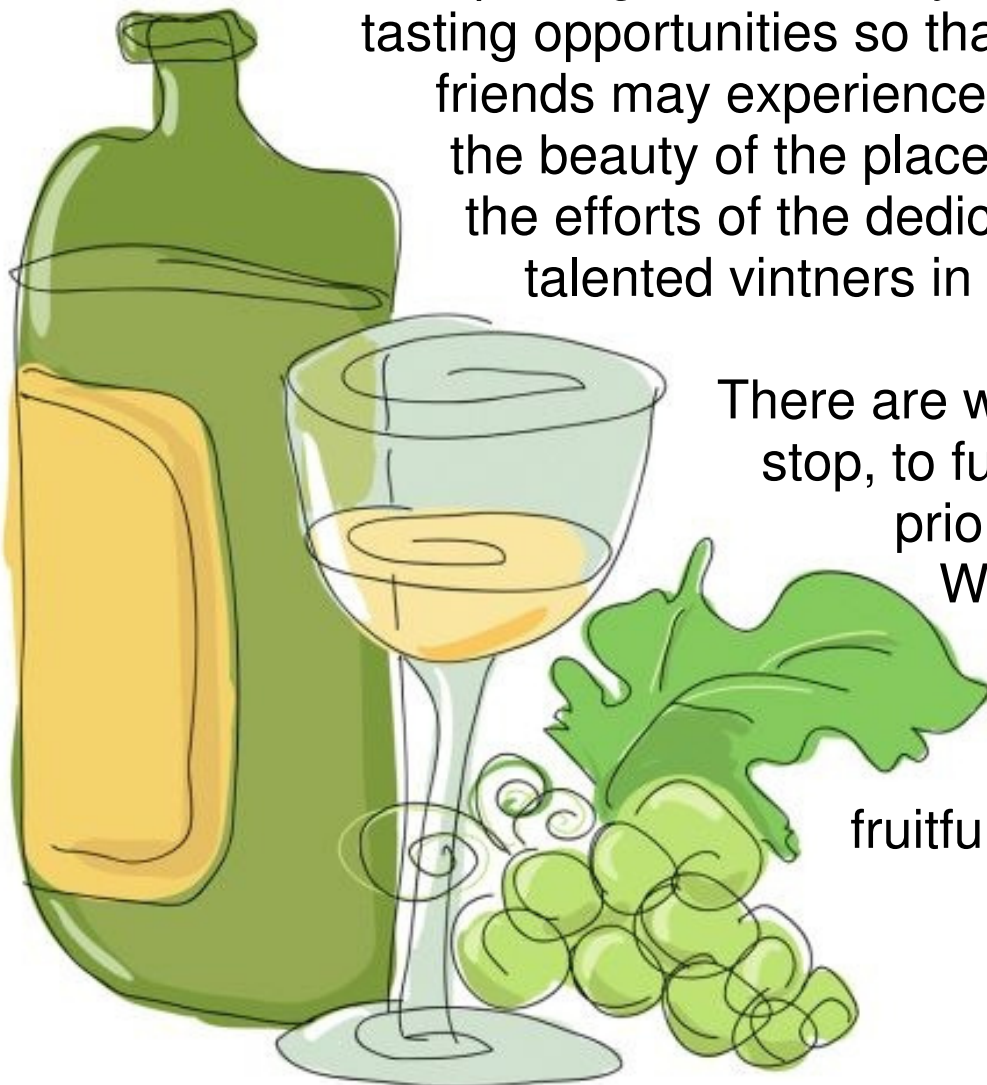
# Sideways.... on the Coast of Maine

The day will begin with a short ride to Bucksport to visit Maine's Fort Knox and the recently constructed Penobscot Narrows Bridge and Observatory. Fort Knox was constructed after the War of 1812 to protect the Penobscot River from possible British attack. It is a fine example of stone construction, has undergone substantial renovation in the past few years and enjoys wonderful views of the River. From the observatory deck you can see for miles and miles.....

From Bucksport we'll travel a few miles to the Village of Winterport to visit the Winterport Winery. At this stop there will be tasting of their various locally produced wines and a gourmet lunch.
